IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

1. The April 30, 2019, deadline for mediation currently set forth in the Amended Scheduling Order is vacated and stayed.
2. The deposition of the Receiver appointed in *SEC v. Wealth Management LLC et al.*, Civil Action No. 1:09-cv-506 WCG (E.D. Wisconsin) is stayed.
3. The Parties shall appear for a status conference (in person or telephonically) on September 10, 2019, at 8:30 a.m., at which time the Court will evaluate whether to continue or lift the stays of mediation and the deposition of the Receiver appointed in *SEC v. Wealth Management LLC et al.*, Civil Action No. 1:09-cv-506 WCG (E.D. Wisconsin).

4. Unless otherwise specified herein, the Amended Scheduling Order dated March 12, 2019, remains in effect and AXA's Motion for Stay of Discovery is DENIED.
